Greetings Sisters and Brothers:

In 2020, the Foundation reported a significant drop in donations due to the constraints of operating during the pandemic. Chapters were unable to meet and special events that normally raised a significant amount of money for the Foundation's charities had to be cancelled. As things began to open up in 2021 and restrictions started to be lifted, our members responded by donating over \$171,000 to the Foundation. While this is great news, it should be noted that \$42,000 was received from a single bequest.

Your generosity has been outstanding, and we encourage you to continue to assist our members in these unprecedented times by making contributions to one of the Foundation's Funds. Our Worthy Grand Matron and Worthy Grand Patron have selected Fly Brave Foundation and Cannie Companions for Autism as their special projects for 2022.
